SUBJECT: Students with Disabilities

Health Sciences Charter School recognizes the existence of individual differences in the intellectual, social, emotional and physical development of children attending school. In recognizing these differences, the school supports a system of services offered to our students with disabilities.

Program Accessibility

Health Sciences Charter School affirms its compliance with those sections of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 dealing with program accessibility.

Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act prohibits discrimination against qualified individuals with disabilities in federally assisted programs or activities solely on the basis of disability. The Health Sciences Charter School shall make its' programs and facilities accessible to all of its' students with disabilities.

The Health Sciences Charter School official responsible for coordination of activities relating to compliance with Section 504 is the Health Sciences Charter School Principal. He shall provide information, including complaint procedures to any person who feels his or her rights under *Section 504* have been violated by the Health Sciences Charter School or its' officials.

All students with disabilities shall be provided with full access and opportunity to participate in Health Sciences Charter School programs and extracurricular activities which are available to all other students enrolled in the Health Sciences Charter School.

Parents/guardians of students with disabilities shall receive timely notice of such programs and activities.
