**SUBJECT: Transportation**

Health Sciences Charter School (Health Sciences) will provide students in Grades 9-12 who are City of Buffalo residents and meet the Buffalo Public School eligibility requirements with a bus pass through the Niagara Frontier Transit Authority.

Students residing outside the City of Buffalo within a 15-mile radius of the School will be provided transportation by their Home School District.

Health Sciences' Assistant Principal will oversee all aspects of student transportation including communication with the Home School Districts as well as with incoming parents to ensure that they submit written transportation requests, no later than April 1 each year, to the school district in which they reside, when applicable.
