Bus Driver/School Support Monitor

Position Summary:

Under the direction of school-based administration, the Bus Driver/School Support Monitor assists in maintaining a safe school environment by monitoring student activity throughout Health Sciences Charter School.

Responsibilities:

- 1. Monitors students throughout the day at arrival, breakfast, lunch, transition times, fire drills, building evacuations, and dismissal in the hallways.
- 2. Responsible for subbing in classrooms as needed.
- 3. Responsible for coverage in the cafeteria. Monitor and supervise students in the cafeteria. Manage students throughout the lunch line.
- 4. Responsible for the removal of disruptive students from the classroom
- 5. Responsible for covering the front desk and all duties that come along with it such as answering phones, greet all visitors, make copies as requested.
- 6. Responsible for transportation of students on the school bus to all athletic and academic related functions.
- 7. Maintains professional standards per HSCS in an urban environment.
- 8. Oversee maintenance, inspections, record keeping, fueling, and certification of the bus through the NY State DOT.
- 9. Other duties as assigned.

Qualifications:

- High School Diploma or GED Equivalency
- Two (2) years of experience working in a school setting preferred
- Must be able to provide evidence of successful experience working with high school students in an educational setting.
- Must possess and maintain a valid drivers' license.
- Must possess and maintain a valid CDL License.
- Must pass drug screening assessment, background record investigation and federal, state and local fingerprint checks
- Therapeutic crisis intervention and de-escalation training preferred.

Skills:

- Ability to make difficult decisions independently, involving multiple functions within and/or outside of the organization.
- Ability to be flexible, detail oriented, and communicate effectively with school personnel and students
- Ability to address and deescalate conflict in a professional manner.
- Ability to respond to emergency situation while maintaining composure and demonstrating appropriate professionalism and restraint at all times
- Strong planning, problem solving, organizational, verbal and written communication and interpersonal skills.
